Children with learning disabilities typically struggle to make progress in the regular classroom environment. They require structured, sequential programmes with far more opportunity for revision and practise than does the child who has no difficulty with literacy. This is best provided in an individual or small group situation. This three day course will cover:

- The causes and defining features of specific learning disabilities
- Phonological and phonemic awareness
- Assessment tools
- Understanding and using a psychologist's report
- The use of structured, sequential multi-sensory methods of teaching
- The use of computer programs
- Techniques for older students and adults



This course will prove useful for any teacher who works with students with literacy difficulties and is a pre-requisite for all tutors who are recommended by DSF.

**Presenter:** Mandy Nayton is currently the Executive Officer of DSF Literacy and Clinical Services. She is a practising psychologist and qualified teacher with extensive experience in the field of educational and counselling psychology. Mandy assesses children, teenagers and adults struggling with the acquisition of effective literacy skills and recommends appropriate classroom-based and individual strategies. She also runs numerous courses on literacy acquisition and learning difficulties both for DSF and in association with the University of Western Australia's Child Study Centre.
