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Current research conclusively demonstrates that the most effective reading programs include both explicit and systematic phonemic awareness and phonics instruction. Ideally these programs should be delivered using a range of multi-sensory activities with a significant increase in intensity (e.g., one-on-one or small group). This is particularly the case for struggling students. The Hickey Multi-sensory Program is a very effective, highly structured program that achieves excellent results.

Participants in this one day workshop will be taken through the structure of the Hickey Program and will prepare activities for the first 30 sessions. Materials will be provided including: a full set of plastic alphabet letters (rec. retail \$35); example reading and spelling cards; and, a wide range of worksheets and activities.
