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Current research conclusively demonstrates that the most effective reading programs include both explicit and systematic phonemic awareness and phonics instruction. Ideally these programs should be delivered using a range of multi-sensory activities with a significant increase in intensity (e.g., one-on-one or small group). This is particularly the case for struggling students.

Participants in this one day workshop will examine The Hickey Multi-Sensory Course; a structured and systematic evidence-based literacy program. A pre-requisite for participating in this workshop is the completion of the Hickey Workshop, Part 1. Participants will review more complex letter to sound patterns in addition to strategies to implement the program effectively in the classroom.
